Board Member Expectations:

The FPGD Board meets at 4:30 pm on the last Monday of every month except July and December. We ask our members to commit to at least 8 of these 10 meetings. The meetings typically run about one and a half hours. We try to meet at least once per quarter in person.

The Board is also comprised of 3 sub-committees: Development (which focuses on marketing, fundraising and donor relations), Finance (which provides oversight and direction on the organizations finances and financial polices), and Governance (review and updates organizational policies and documents).
